Community Service Tax Credit Program (CSP)

Non-profit organizations can apply for the Community Service Tax Credit Program, which gives 50% to 70% tax credits for donors to the non-profits. \$1 million of these tax credits are set aside for early childhood facilities and projects. The application process is designed to be streamlined and easy to use.
