





OVERVIEW OF REVIEW PROCESS

- Applications submitted to Children's Cabinet
 - 28 received (10 new applicants)
- Initial review by Children's Cabinet staff for completeness, required documentation
 - 28 applications eligible
- Eligible applications reviewed by an external panel including parents and representatives from early childhood, child welfare, and special education
- Scored proposals reviewed by Children's Cabinet staff


