





# ECBG/KPP COMMON APPLICATION PURPOSE

- Integrate the Early Childhood Block Grant (ECBG) and Kansas
  Preschool Pilot (KPP) grant applications into the Common App to
  streamline applications and reduce grant-writing and reporting
  burdens for grantees who apply for and/or receive state funding.
- Efficiencies for state agencies in reviewing and awarding grant submission and better understanding of the impact of state funding and alignment of different state funding streams.
- Blend and braid funding for highest level impact

- Scored proposals reviewed by KCCTF & KSDE staff

### EARLY CHILDHOOD ADVISORY COUNCIL

#### **Executive Order 20-02:**

- Established the Children's Cabinet as the State Advisory Council on Early Childhood Education and Care, a requirement of federal Head Start legislation.
- Established a volunteer Early Childhood Recommendations Panel to offer guidance to the Children's Cabinet.
