#### CHILD AND FAMILY WELL-BEING DASHBOARD

- **Purpose**: To better understand community-level factors that impact children and families and articulate the benefits of investing in child maltreatment prevention. The dashboard will serve as a visual tool for translating data to policy makers, private sector partners, and partners in the child and family well-being system.
- Timeline: Phase 1- Research and Development (2023), Phase 2 Review, improvement, and dissemination (2024-2025)
- Funding: Supplemental CBCAP funding: \$371,320 (2.5-year budget)

# Executive Order 23-01

## EARLY CHILDHOOD TRANSITION TASK FORCE

E.O. No. 23-01 establishes the Early Childhood Transition Task Force. The Task Force is charged with reviewing Kansas' early childhood programs and developing a roadmap for the creation of a new state, cabinet-level agency focused solely on supporting the success of our youngest Kansans.

**Vision**: All Kansas children – especially those between zero and five years of age – deserve healthy childhoods that are supported by a robust early childhood system which improves outcomes and effectively provides high-quality early care and education, adapts to the needs of families and communities, and is equitably accessible to all communities across the state.





#### SPARK Funding MELISSA ROOKER, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

#### **SPARK FUNDING - DECEMBER 2022**

- **SPARK**/Recovery Office announced funding to support health and education initiatives, including expansion of child care (\$20 million)
  - DCF providing additional CCDF ARPA funding for child care (\$20 million)
- Blended funding will be available as grants from the Children's Cabinet known as Child Care Capacity Accelerator
  - <u>Purpose</u>: Support construction/major renovation and operational support to add high-quality and sustainable licensed child care seats in Kansas.
  - <u>Cabinet Role</u>: Administer funding program, including RFP/application and review process, funding approval, support for grantees, and reporting obligations (both compliance and impact)


