The purpose: construction of multi-purpose community facilities that support work, education, health monitoring and child care needs of families.

Outcomes:

- Increased number of individuals receiving access to education, including early childhood education
- Increased access to physical, mental, and/or behavioral health needs in the community
- Increased access to supports that enable work, including broadband
- Increased access to full-day/full-year child care for children birth to 5 years

- o\$38 million total
- Funding Source US Treasury (Broadband funding)
- Construction-only
- Projects must have explicit design considerations to enable ALL the following: licensed child care, work, education, and health monitoring
- Must have operational sustainability plan + 15% project asset

- <u>Round Two:</u>
 - Applications Due: December 18 at 5pm
 - Cabinet Approval: February 2, 2024 (virtual)

Project Spending Timeline:

Nov. 2023 (round 1 awards) or Mar. 2024 (round 2 awards) – Sept 2025



PROPOSED FUNDING SLATE MAP CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND GRANTEES


